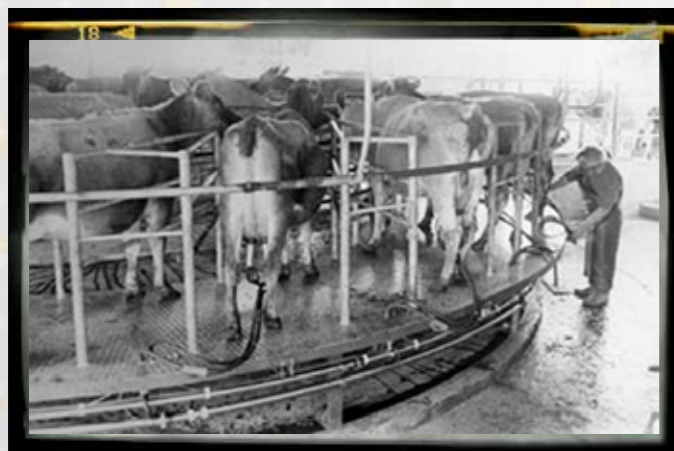
1917

- In 1917 **Norman Daysh**, a little-known farmer from Pahiatua revolutionised dairy farming around the world by launching the **first mechanised milking system**.



1952

- In 1952, after being tired of stooping down to attach the cluster to the cow, Waikato farmer **Ronald Sharp** invented what is now known as the **herringbone cowshed**.



1968

- Then in the late 1960s, Taranaki farmer **Merv Hicks** turned milking around with his invention of the **rotary milking platform**. The turnstile design was a revolution in breaking the barriers of how many cows could be milked in an hour.

A modern rotary milking system coupled with key automation technology can provide critical advantages to help fine tune and improve the overall performance of your unique dairy operation. Increases in herd sizes has prompted recent investment in rotary technology as dairy operators look for more efficient systems to milk their herd. The global labour shortage has also fueled more interest in rotary systems because of their ability to milk more cows with fewer people.

Platform performance

Rotary platforms can range from 28 to 80 points although some have been manufactured in larger sizes, up to 140 points for commercial dairy farms. The number of points designed for a rotary depends on the size of the herd and any future plans for herd expansion. Research suggests a rotary system becomes the dairy type of choice once herd sizes grow beyond 500 cows. A rotary can be fine tuned to achieve optimum milking time by adjusting the rotation speed of the platform to meet the dairy farm's milking strategy.

Research and development

There has been extensive research and development to refine rotary milking systems to meet the needs of a modern dairy farm operator. Coupled with milking automation technology such as automatic cup removers, automatic teat spray and auto sorting, rotary systems can deliver higher efficiency and productivity outcomes for your dairy operation. More advanced automation options can be added later on to gain even more efficiencies, such as milk meters, yield indicators, advanced pulsation systems with teat health detection capability and auto plant wash systems.

Rotary milking system solutions provide higher gains for farmers but with lower labour requirements, providing more time for staff to attend to other important jobs outside of the milking parlour.

Cow comfort and cow flow are paramount at milking time and rotary systems can be configured for quiet operation which makes for a more relaxed environment for the animals and the operator to work in. Strategic design and placement of entry and exit points ensure good cow flow less affected by operator-animal interaction.
